- 7) Not afraid to share your weaknesses with the congregation, not to condone it, but to let everyone know that you like them are praying daily to be more like Christ in living your life.

- 9) Willing to counsel members of the community and church family, but being aware of your limitations and who can provide additional therapy when needed.
